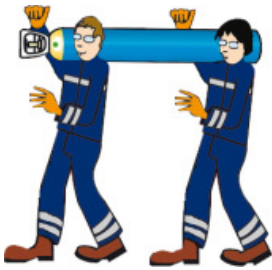


Safe Handling of Cylinders

Moving Cylinders Around

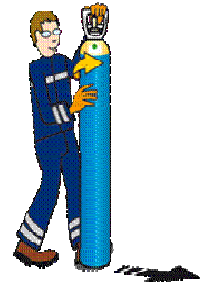


Never carry the cylinder on the shoulder or lift it to move or roll 2 cylinders at a time



Use Cylinder trolley to move gas cylinders over a long distance

Roll one cylinder at a time for short distance only



Back injury.



Never try to "catch" a falling cylinder

Move Cylinders in Secured manner in **pallets** using Fork Lift Trucks



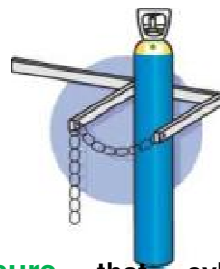
Securing Cylinders



Never Allow Free-standing cylinders at the site.. Must be placed in Pens or in a wall support structure & attached by a strap or chain



Check Valve protection is in place before moving cylinders



Ensure that cylinders remain upright & secured by using Restraints- ratchet belts/ steel loops



Personal Protective Equipment



Beware of trapped hands when handling cylinder



Use Safety Gloves

Protect your eyes for any accidental release of gases



Beware of falling cylinder. Wear Safety Shoes
